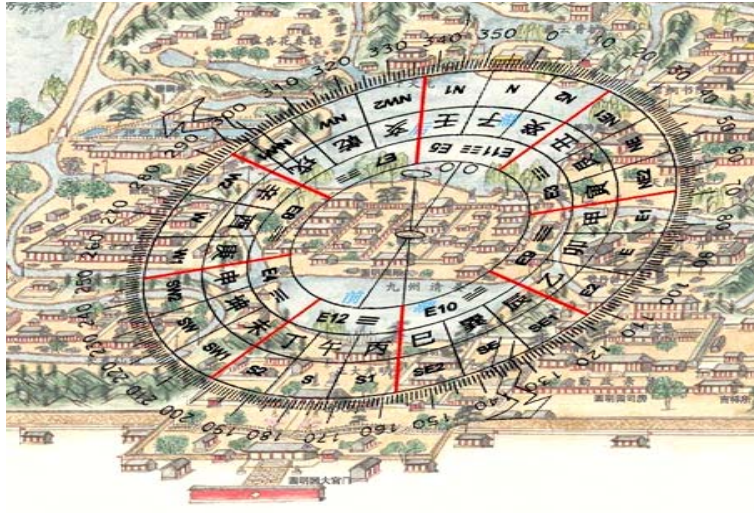

Abstract:

Feng Shui (wind and water) is the Chinese concept about a resource that influences all the substances on the Earth. This deep understanding of the connection between nature and humanity involves many fields of sciences. The ancient Chinese science has been developed for more than four thousand years. The presentation tries to open a door to people who are interested in the connection between building, human beings and nature, an integration planning, which can be utilized in different scales from micro space to city planning.
